With over **15,000 hectares**, it is one of the largest **ecosystems** in the region.

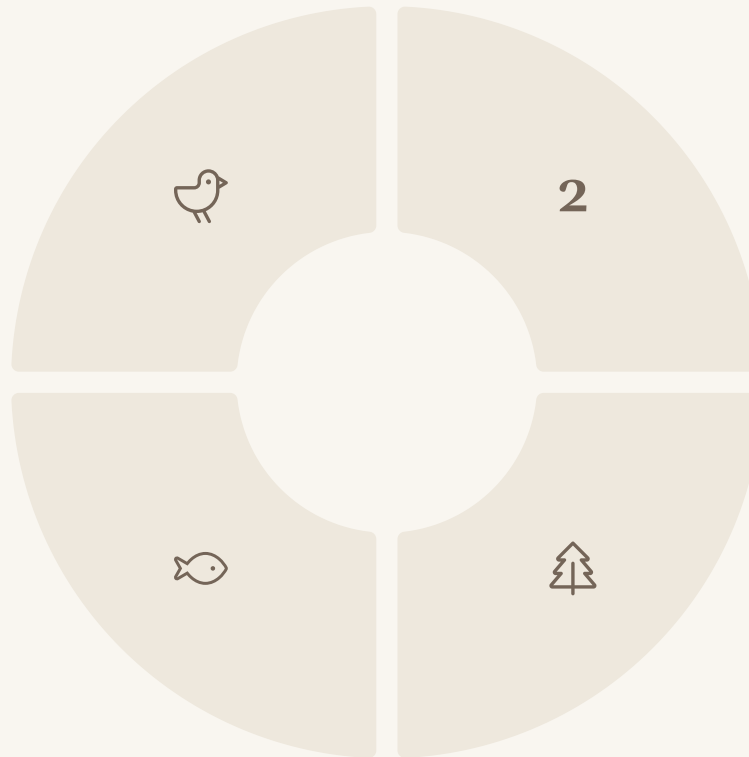
Exceptional biodiversity
